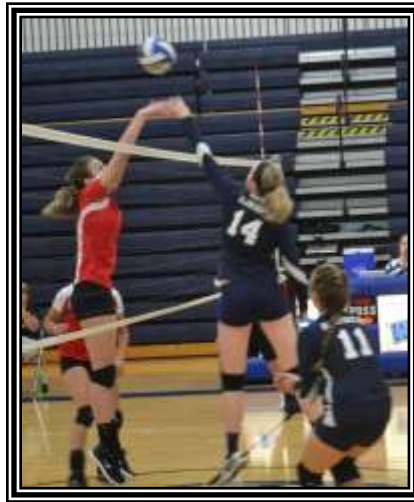

Reserve "B"

-awarded to non varsity athletes who have played several games against other schools reserve level teams

Silver Varsity "B" certificate

-awarded to athlete who has met the varsity requirements of his/her sport, but has already earned a varsity letter that school year.

Chevron

-awarded to athletes who have met the sports' requirements for playing at the varsity level

-awarded for each sport the athlete plays varsity

White participation certificate

-athlete finished the season in as a member of the team in good standing

Freshman numbers

-First time an athlete finishes a sports season as a member of the team in good standing
