

Introduction - Compiled by Athletic Director, Bryan Pennix Summer 2014 *Blanchester Football 1*

This football brochure has been compiled to inform the general public, press, radio, and boosters of the Blanchester High School Football program.

Most of the information in this brochure covers the "modern era" of varsity football since it began in 1964. (Bob Farmer, Head Football coach 1967)

The history of football at Blanchester High school begins in the fall of 1908. Superintendent, Professor C. Lee Leahy, coached the squad of 11 boys. Coach Leahy had played the game in high school and college in Columbus, Ohio. Being the 1st and only team in Clinton County to have a football team the Blan boys traveled out of town to play schools such as Wilmington College Prep School, Greenfield, Hillsboro, Milford and high schools around Cincinnati.

Transportation was quite a problem for the team. They usually made it to games by railroad and the traction line.

The first team of 1908 had to furnish their own equipment and shoes. Team jerseys were usually old sweaters or under shirts. The team dressed in the boiler room of the Main Street building. Opposition for practice was made up of high school boys, grade school boys, and two elementary schools.

The most outstanding game played during the 1908, 1909, 1910 was at Wellston, Ohio. Wellston High school claimed to be Southern Ohio champions and was challenged by the Brown and Blue of Blanchester High. Traveling by train and trolley the Blan team not only showed up for the game but returned victorious, 6-0.

As I recall, Mr. Samuel Nicely was coach, and a good one. We had a number of good boys from Midland City and Westboro. We played surrounding schools, namely Hillsboro, Greenfield, Milford, Xenia, Hughes of Cincinnati, and Wilmington.

1917

We had about the same roster of boys. We opened the season playing Company B who were in training for World War I. War was declared April 7th, 1917. The boys left for Camp Sheridan in Montgomery, Alabama in the fall of 1917. We played Milford, Wilmington, Hillsboro, Xenia, and Greenfield. John Smith was the coach.

1918

We met but due to the war, did not field a team, as I remember. We had no coach as Mr. Nicely, Mr. Smith and most other young men were in the Armed Services.

Football stopped until 1922 due to World War I.

1922

The fall of 1922 witnessed the revival of football at B.H.S. The matter of equipment and material was a big problem, which was overcome by the students and people of Blanchester. Games were scheduled with Wilmington, Greenfield, Clarksburg, Bainbridge, Milford, and Bellevue, Ky. Records show they won 2 and had close scores on some others.

Football continued for two more years and then in 1927, due to the depression years, it stopped until the fall of 1963. With head coach Ben Hubbard calling out for candidates, approximately 30 boys reported. The 1963 team did not play a full varsity schedule, but played such schools as Lincoln Heights, Goshen, and Ross.

From the 1963 Wilmington News Journal

"Blan's Brand New Ball Club To Play Saturday Blanchester High school's brand new football team journeys to Felicity for a 12:45 p. m. Saturday ballgame, the premier of the Wildcats* first schedule since World War II. Ben Hubbard reports that the team has a surprising grasp of most of the fundamentals, and from several aspects, "Will look like a veteran ballclub instead of a brand new team." "We have a good aerial attack,"* Hubbard reports, "with Eddie Huffman and Ron Kirby as good receivers. Power for the running attack comes from 200 pound fullback Gene Gilbert. The breakaway element is Ted Williams, who had a 90 yard gainer in scrimmage against Seven Mik, followed by big runs from 80 and 70 yards out.

In pre-season scrimmages, the Wildcats jousted with Williamsburg, Mason and Seven Mile, getting their ears pinned back each time. The scrimmages preceded this week's work on Blanchester's pass defense, and the opposition made full use of this advantage. Probable starting lineups for Saturday include Ron Kirby at one end and Steve Dunn or Dave Lyons at the other. Tackles are B. Papet and Brent Snell. Guards are Tom Marsh and Tom Irons. Bob McGuire is center. Williams and Les Osborne are halfbacks. Quarterback Leary and fullback Gilbert round out the offensive backfield. Offensive line weight average is just under 200 pounds. ON DEFENSE, the front line will average more than 200 pounds. The five-man line includes Lyons, Jim Walker, Papet, Snell and Kirby. Dave Irvin and Marsh are middle linebackers. Bob McGuire and Louis Volk are corners with Ted Williams and Leary as defensive halfbacks. A lot of defensive action will be seen by Emery Terrell, Tommy Irons and Roger Smith. Bob McGuire and Dave Irvin were praised by the coach as "smaller players who do a real job on defense." A big "Meet the Team" pep rally is scheduled at 7:30 p. m. Friday at the high school athletic field.

Cheerleaders will be on hand, as well as the high school band. Members of the team and coaching staff will be introduced and the rally will be followed with the traditional bonfire."

Hatfield, Warren County Superintendent of Schools.

1975 Tough Northeastern final victim, 14-6 Blanchester finishes 10-0

Downtown Blanchester Friday night was a symphony of automobile horns, the universal herald of high school athletic success. And, there was a lot to blare about. From Church St, to Vine, and from Baldwin to Old Broadway, the cars returning from Clermont Northeastern High School proclaimed the same wondrous thing. Their Blanchester High School football team had done what no Blanchester team had done before, what no Fort Ancient Valley Conference team had done before, and what no (Clinton County team had done since 1936. By defeating Clermont Northeastern 14-6, they finished their season undefeated and untied. The victory did not come easy against Northeastern, which entered the game 7-6-2. and was champions of the Clermont County League. Northeastern controlled the ball in the first quarter, but the Wildcats were saved by two interceptions, one by Cliff Lawson, and one by Mike O'Rourke. Blanchester scored first with 9:55 to go in the first half, on a four yard run by Mike O'Rourke.

Three plays before the touchdown, with third down on the Northeastern 36 yard line, quarterback Jack O'Rourke completed a 27 yard pass to Mike Barr, taking the ball to the nine yard line. On the kickoff, Northeastern fumbled and Blanchester recovered, but the Wildcats were unable to capitalize. They punted, and Northeastern began their only scoring drive of the game, beginning on their own 27 yard line. The touchdown was scored on a one yard run by halfback Ron Hitt. It was the first touchdown scored by rushing against the Wildcats all year long. The conversion attempt was a costly one for the Rockets. Not only did it fail, but their starting quarterback, Bob Farrell, was injured on the play, and didn't see action the rest of the game. The Rockets had to play the rest of the game with a freshman, Jeff Jackson, at quarterback. It was a tough situation for a youngster to be in.

Unfortunately for Northeastern, he not only couldn't take the ball to the goal line, but he was intercepted twice. After the Rockets kicked off following their touchdown. Blanchester tailed to move the ball, and called a timeout on a fourth down play, with the ball on their own 48. WJien play resumed. Jack O'Rourke Jr. took the snap as if to punt, but then handed off to Law son. He failed to pick up the needed yardage, and Northeastern took over.

A parade honoring the Blanchester football team, which went 10-0 this year and won the Fort Ancient Valley Conference, will begin in downtown Blanchester at 9 a.m. Monday. Friday, after the Northeastern game, Blanchester Police escorted the team through downtown Blanchester. The Wildcat marching band also participated in the parade. Police Chief Glenn Thompson said, "We turned the town over to them, the town was theirs. All we did was keep them from getting hit by automobiles. "It's not every year you have a team that's undefeated, and champions at that."
