My vision for Athletics at Blanchester

We field full teams in sports where athletes compete as individuals (golf, cross country, bowling, tennis, wrestling and track & field), which gives us the opportunity to compete for league titles.

RULES & REGULATIONS - ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility requirements - https://www.ohsaa.org/

Scholarship (Grades):

- Checked quarterly and weekly (after the 3rd week of the quarter). Students must have minimum 1.0 GPA AND be passing enough credits (5 for HS/4 for MS)

Attendance: must be at school by to participate unless approved by an administrator (Send an email)

- Must be at school by 8:30 am and can not leave early (district rule)

ALL transfer students should check with administration about eligibility (Send an email)

- There may be paperwork that you are required to fill out to gain full eligibility

HEALTH & SAFETY

Physicals - Must have one on file to participate (good for 13 months)

Parents/Students must also sign a number of other forms (located in Final Forms)

Concussions

- Must get clearance from physician or other health care provider

Athletic Trainer

Substance Use - Alcohol, Drugs and Tobacco

- There will be an athletic consequence associated with use/possession (in athletic handbook, which is also in Final Forms)

SPORTING BEHAVIOR

Be Positive, Be Respectful, Act with Integrity

- You represent us when you are at events

Know Your Role - Athlete, Fan, Coach or Official

- Which one are you at each contest?

Shortage of officials, don't run off the ones who are willing to work

You will be asked to leave if you are taunting, threatening, using inappropriate language, throwing objects, or interfering with the conduct of the game.

- If you are asked to leave, you will not be permitted to attend <u>any</u> extracurricular contest (even of a different sport) for the next 20% of the season.

TICKETS TO EVENTS

- Can purchase with cash at the gate OR online via Hometown Ticketing
- In-season athletes will receive free admission to home contests. They will need to sign in at the gate.
- Non-school age children do not require a ticket

SPORTS PASSES

Passes only available for purchase through Hometown Ticketing

- Good for home contests all year long (HS and MS)
- Only the individual whose name appears on the pass will be admitted
- \$100 for adults (plus processing fee)
- \$75 for students (plus processing fee)

Adults aged 65 and over will be given a FREE all year all sports pass if they visit the HS office and show ID anytime during the school day. Senior Citizen passes from last year are still good for this year. They will not need to get another pass.

ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION FEES

Fees support transportation costs and coaching salaries

Cost: \$250/sport, \$600 family cap Payable with cash or check

- Make checks out to Blanchester Local School District

Due before 1st regular season contest

COMMUNICATION

If your athlete is having issues related to the team, they need to talk to the coach

- Teaches athletes to be responsible for themselves and to deal with their own issues
- If issues persist, then parents may contact coach to set up a meeting
